The First Meeting of the G20-Chief Science Advisers Roundtable (G20-CSAR) took place in Ramnagar, Uttarakhand. G20-CSAR is a flagship initiative under India's G20 Presidency led by the Office of the Principal Scientific Adviser to the Government of India.

The roundtable witnessed discussions under the broad themes of Opportunities in One Health for better disease control and pandemic preparedness; Synergizing Global Efforts to Expand Access to Scholarly Scientific Knowledge; Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Accessibility in Science & Technology (S&T); and An

Institutional Mechanism for Inclusive, Continuous and Action-Oriented Global S&T Policy Dialogue.
