The Hon'ble Minister has announced the setting up of IndiaAl Safety Institute under the Safe and Trusted Pillar of the IndiaAl Mission to address Al risks & Safety Challenges.

The IndiaAl Safety Institute will work with all relevant stakeholders, including academia, startups, industry and government ministries/departments, towards ensuring safety, security and trust in Al. The Institute will advance indigenous research and development, based on Indian datasets and contextualized to India's social, economic, cultural, and linguistic diversity.

The Institute, incubated by IndiaAl Mission will be set up on a hub and spoke model with various research and academic institutions, private sector partners joining the hub and taking up projects under the Safe and Trusted Pillar of IndiaAl Mission.

Under the Safe and Trusted pillar, the IndiaAl Mission has selected eight Responsible Al Projects against the first Expression of Interest (EoI). These projects are listed in Annexure 3.

Further IndiaAl has launched the 2nd round of Expression of Interest (Eol) open to Indian Academic Institutes/Organizations, Autonomous bodies, R&D Institutes/Organizations, Startups and Companies.
